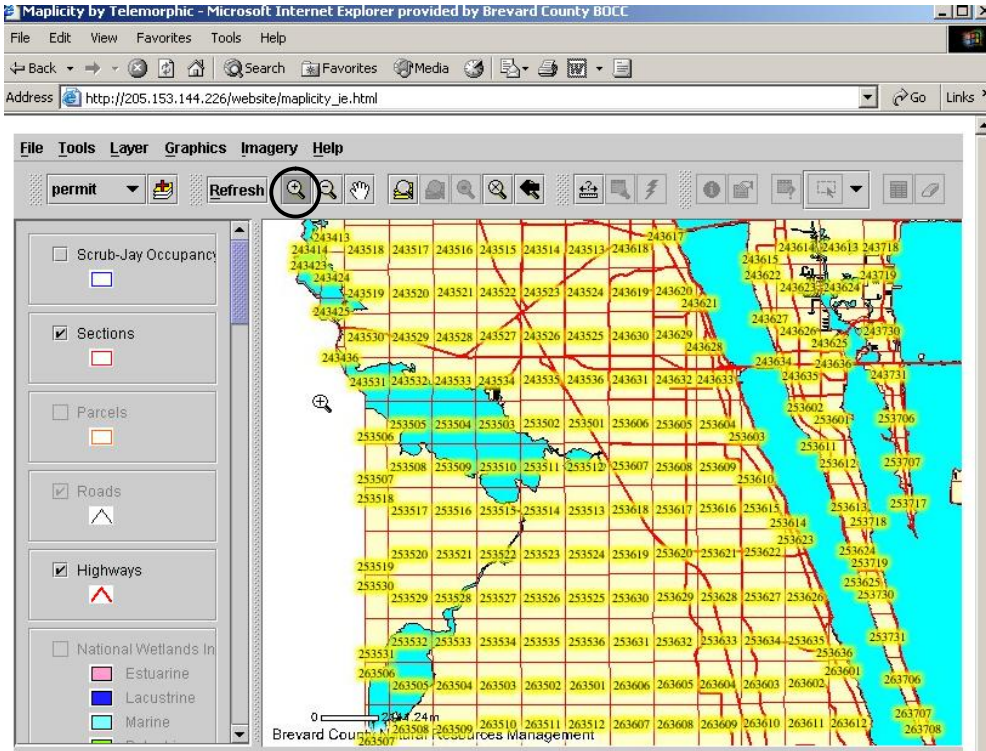


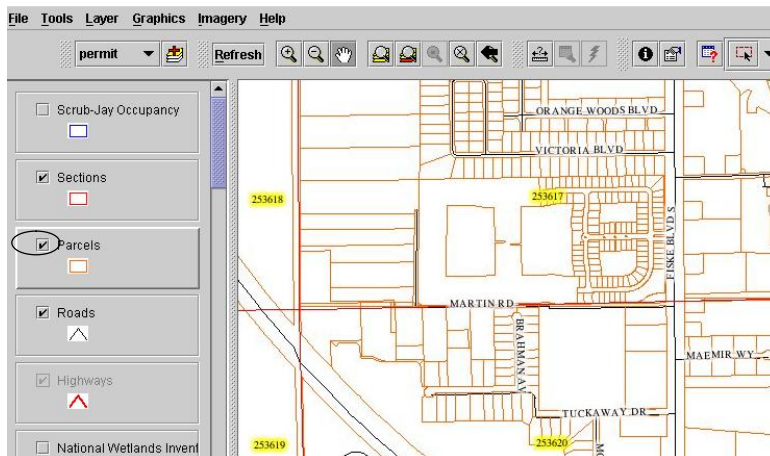
- Click on the + **magnifying glass** to activate this tool. If you click and drag the magnifying tool, a box will appear and the program will zoom in on the area within the box. Use the magnifier to zoom in until Townships, Ranges and Sections appear (they will have yellow backgrounds).



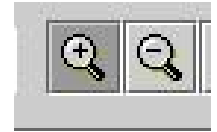
- Click on the Hand tool and then click and drag the mouse to “push” the map up or down, left or right, as needed.
- Use the + **Magnifier Tool** to enlarge the appropriate Section on the map once you have located it.
- Check the small box on the Parcel button. Then click anywhere else on the button to raise the **Parcels button** (if it is not already in this mode) so that it appears 3-D. Click Refresh to display the parcels.



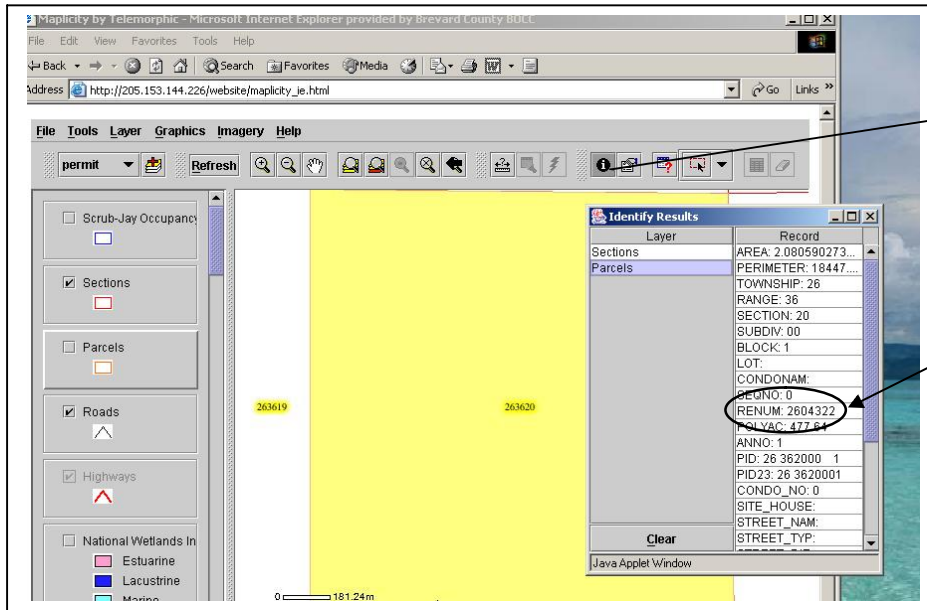
Raised Parcel button with check mark.



- Use the Magnifier tools to zoom in or zoom out and locate the parcel for which you are looking. Click on the “plus” or “minus” magnifier and then click and drag the mouse over the area of the map in which you are interested.



- Click on the Identify tool and then click on a parcel to get detailed information on each parcel.



“Renum” is the tax acct. number. Use this to confirm that you have identified the correct parcel.

- Check the appropriate button on the left (e.g., Scrub Jay Occupancy, National Wetlands Inventory, Flood Plains, Soil Type, etc.) then click the **Refresh** button to see if your parcel is identified within the applicable environmental map layer.
