RE: Definition of "Passive Recreation"

During the December 3, 2008 meeting, the Working Group unanimously approved a definition of Passive Recreation:

Passive Recreation - recreation uses are considered passive where very minimum alteration of vegetation, topography or other native feature is necessary, for the enjoyment of the site amenities. Activities which are considered passive include, but are not limited to, hiking, bicycling, nature observation, camping, picnicking, non-motorized ~~boating, rowing~~ recreation and sports, ~~swimming, picnicking~~, archaeological or historic preservation.

Passive Recreation means recreational uses where very minimum alteration of vegetation, topography or other native feature is necessary for the enjoyment of the site amenities. Activities which are considered passive include, but are not limited to, hiking, bicycling, nature observation, camping, picnicking, non-motorized recreation and sports, and archaeological or historic preservation.
